Africa is a land of mystique, a land of contrasts, nature, people, riches, poverty, a land of potential.

From this land we meet the Maasai, a tribe with a rich culture and heritage, of colour and contrast. Sadly also these people encounter the harsh realities of the poverty and sufferings of so many in this land.

Julius (a local Maasai Warrior and leader in his community and church) and Barbara have joined together to provide a school for educating the children to break this cycle of sickness and poverty and eventually to provide a home for those who may have no home to go to.

There has been 10ha of community land given for the project on the escarpment overlooking the Masai Mara Game Reserve. This is where they plan to build a School, a Dormitory/Home, which will also be a rescue centre for girls and education centre (specifically for Female Genital Mutilation and HIV education). They hope also to build a Clinic for the poor, orphaned and neglected Maasai children in the area, as well as the general community.

Julius currently has 43 children who are meeting in a "make shift school" where when funds are available, he provides porridge in the morning and one meal a day for them as many times it is the only food apart from a drink of milky tea, that they will receive.

The project is planned to be built in 3 stages:

Stage 1 - the school which will be 2 classrooms and each year another will be added to accommodate the children as they progress through the classes, plus fencing the property.

Stage 2 - the Dormitory/Home for orphans which will also be a rescue centre for girls.

Stage 3 - a much needed Clinic.

How can you help?

- Food to feed the children — \$60 per week for Mealie Meal (to make the porridge) and rice/beans for a midday meal.
- Uniforms and shoes for children who do not have these - approximately \$20 per child
- Textbooks/supplies for the school
- The total envisaged for Stage 1 including the fencing is \$40,000
- An underground tank for the storage of water is also needed, the price of this has not as yet been determined.
- Ongoing sponsorship of the children for clothing, food and payment of teachers' wages.

Update 12 April 2012

The fencing has now been completed and as final costs were below what was expected, funds are now available for a storeroom/guard house to be completed on the grounds.
